Georgia's Antebellum Trail, the state's first official Trail, presents the Second Annual Antebellum Trail Pilgrimage on April 21 – 25, 2010. Comprised of seven communities, the Pilgrimage features events and tours along the Trail as well as entrance into private, historic homes not generally open to the general public. The Pilgrimage will transport visitors back in time as they visit historic homes, experience authentic battle sites, view impressive architecture and tour magnificent museums.

Tickets are \$25 and include access to the ticketholder's choice of any seven participating attractions and/or events. Groups of 10 or more receive discounted tickets at \$20. Tickets can be purchased online and at any of the Welcome Centers along the trail immediately prior to and during the Pilgrimage. To enhance the visitor's experience, complementing tours and free events and activities will be featured in the communities during the Pilgrimage.
